IT OFFICER (MARKETING & COMMUNICATIONS)

1. Position Summary

The IT Officer is a member of the Marketing & Communications team whose objective it is to develop, implement, evaluate and support strategic and tactical marketing and communications. This includes external relations, media relations, project marketing, partnership and sponsorship proposals, grant applications, management of website content & overseeing all external documentation. This role will be centred on the creation and management of the team's visual image, primarily within the digital space.

The IT Officer reports to the Marketing & Communications Manager of the University of Melbourne SIFE.

2. Selection Criteria

Eligibility

1. Enrolled student at the University of Melbourne until at least December 2011
2. Willing to commit a minimum of five hours per week, excluding meetings, during non-exam periods
3. You agree to check your preferred email account daily and respond within 48 hours

5. Understanding of digital marketing techniques

6. Outstanding written and verbal communication skills and interpersonal skills
7. High level of organization and ability to manage multiple tasks within strict timelines
8. High level of attention to detail and good eye for design (layout, typography, graphics, etc.)
9. High level of initiative and ability to work independently
10. Creativity and ability to generate innovative ideas

Additional Desirable Selection Criteria

1. Experience in a IT, digital marketing or digital design role
2. Experience with web development and content management
3. Experience with IT administration

2. Average of five hours per week in project tasks (average of 1-2 hours during exams)

- Provide support to Marketing & Communications Manager, other members of the Marketing & Communications team, and marketing officers within each project
